IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING AMHERST COURTS AND CLERKS' OFFICES OPERATIONS:

PLEASE READ

Effective immediately, due to the current public health concerns surrounding COVID-19 (Coronavirus), which has been declared a pandemic by the World Health Organization, the Clerk's Office for the Amherst Circuit Court, Amherst General District Court and Amherst J&DR District Court are taking the following precautions in an effort to protect you, other members of the community, and court personnel.

COURTS

A. INDIVIDUALS SHOULD NOT ENTER THE BUILDING IF THEY HAVE:

- a. visited China, Iran, South Korea, any European countries, or any other high-risk countries identified by the CDC in the previous (14) fourteen days;
- b. traveled domestically within the United States where COVID-19 has sustained widespread community transmission;
- c. been asked to quarantine, isolate, or self-monitor by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
- d. been diagnosed with, or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with, COVID-19;
 - e. a fever, cough, or shortness of breath; or
- f. resided with or been in close contact with any person in the above-mentioned categories.

If you are an attorney, party, juror or witness for a case scheduled to be heard and one of the above provisions applies to you, DO NOT come into the Courthouse, but contact the appropriate Clerk's Office:
